#### AP Exam Make-ups

**Students who were absent from an AP exam and need to make it up in the late session must come see**

**Ms. van Keulen in Room 261 to register on Friday, May 18, 2012.** All students must bring a check payable to LaGuardia High School for \$40 and proof of the reason that they were absent.

The following are acceptable reasons to miss an AP exam:

- Sickness on the day of the exam (This requires a doctor's note or a note from a parent or guardian stating that the child was sick.)
- A court order (Documentation is required.)
- A funeral

Please note that we will not administer late session exams for foreign language and music theory. These are very technical exams that are difficult to administer, and we do not have proctors for additional testing days.

Extended time AP tests will be administered in the Library. Please refer to the 2012 AP Exam Schedule in this installment of the Second Floor Scoop and on LaProgram.org. Note whether your test(s) will be given in the morning or afternoon.

#### NYCDOE Social Media Guidelines

Please review the following salient points from the recently released "NYC Department of Education Social Media Guidelines":

- Examples of social media include, but are not limited to, social networks, blogs, Internet Web sites, Internet forums, and wikis.
- Examples of social media include, but are not limited to, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Google+, and Flickr.
- DOE employees should treat professional social media space and communication like a classroom and/or a professional workplace.
- DOE employees should not communicate with students who are currently enrolled in DOE schools on personal social media sites.
- If DOE employees receive a request from a current DOE student to connect or communicate through a personal social media site, they should refuse the request.
- If the default setting for comments is turned on, the comments on the site must be monitored on a daily basis.
- DOE employees should not use their personal e-mail address for professional social media activities.
- DOE employees will be required to obtain their supervisor's approval before setting up a professional social media presence.
- The DOE will regularly monitor professional social media sites to protect the school community.
