### Regents Registration

Any student who is not in a Regents-terminating class but *does* need to take the Regents should see a guidance counselor before Wednesday, June 6, to register. Any student who does not register cannot take the exam.



### Programming

On **Tuesday, May 29**, each student who is not a senior will receive a Request Inform Report; this is a list of classes for next year. A student may see a guidance counselor for any of the following reasons:

- to drop an AP class that the student requested on Daedalus
- to register for an off-track foreign language class that was not available in Daedalus
- to discuss any other scheduling concern

***Be aware that counselors will not add honors or AP courses to student schedules if they did not use Daedalus between April 16-April 29 to request classes!***

# Programming Letter - Spring 2012

Dear Student,

On Tuesday, May 29, 2012, you will receive a tentative list of your approved classes for the next school year. While reviewing your list of requested classes, you will notice unfamiliar codes. This is because the Department of Education changed the course codes this year; however, course titles are similar to the ones you have seen in the past.

- **Automatic Processing:** Most of your course requests were processed automatically following standard sequencing in all academic subjects and some studio classes. (Your input was not necessary). For example, if you currently take English 2 (ninth grade English) you will automatically be promoted to English 3 (tenth grade English). If you had not requested a science class and you needed one, a science course was added to your request list based on your transcript information.
- **Daedalus Preferences:** If you selected classes in Daedalus and some of the classes you selected are not on the list you receive, follow the steps listed below.
- **AP and Honors:** If you added your name to a wait list for AP or/and honors classes and were not accepted into these classes, please speak to the department chairperson and your current teacher. If you are a senior and have the request EES87QHR, see Ms. van Keulen about the English class you would like to request.
- **Arts Electives:** Some classes did not run due to low enrollment. You were given your second choice; please see your guidance counselor if you have any questions. If you did not choose classes in Daedalus, you were given classes automatically based on availability.

- **Music Electives:** If you were accepted for an additional ensemble (your fourth music class), you may request to be placed in the class in September.
- **Eleven period day:** We cannot accommodate 11 periods. A student must see Ms. Van Keulen if the request for classes includes too many courses. When counting periods, Lunch and Physical Education are each considered a period. In addition, Biology AP, Chemistry AP and the double period art classes need to be counted as two periods.
- **Drama and Technical Theater:** All drama and tech. students will take Physical Education. The seniors will also take Health in addition to Physical Education during the first semester of the school year.
- **Art Seniors:** If you did not select an art class, please see Ms. Van Keulen.
- **Meeting with a Guidance Counselor:** Please go to your guidance counselor with the following issues:
  - \*You have listed on your request of classes for next year a class you already passed
  - \*You have no lunch
  - \*You are in an off-track world language
  - \*You are a senior and have the following code: EES87QHR.

Please see your guidance counselor during your lunch or your free period on: May 29 – Juniors, May 30 – Sophomores, May 31- Freshmen.

Be aware that counselors will not add any courses if you did not use Daedalus between April 16-April 29 to request classes!
