AP Examinations

Registration for AP Examinations starts on Wed., Mar. 2.

Each AP teacher will give AP students an explanatory letter and Daedalus log-in information on Wed., Mar. 2.

The deadline to register and pay for your AP exams is Tue., Mar. 22. If you are paying by check or money order, bring your envelope to Ms. Fogel in Room 237. If you wish to pay online, visit LaProgram.org. NO LATE REGIS-TRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED!

To enable students to register for AP examinations, every student enrolled in at least one AP class will receive their Daedalus username and password. You may have received this information before. If that is the case and you have already changed your password, use the last password you had. Your teacher will go over the registration process during class.

Each student will receive their log-in information only one time. Students with more than one AP class will receive their letter from only one of their AP teachers; therefore, AP teachers may not have log-in information for some students. These students should have received it through another class.



If you wish to have a visitor to the building, you must now first complete an application, which is available in department offices or at the main desk

in the lobby. This visitor application must be completed at least one week in advance of the visit.

The form you are asked to complete requests that you state the purpose of the visit and requires the approval of your department supervisor.
