

Early Dismissals and Morning AP Exams

In general, students cannot leave the school until the end of their regular school day without parental permission and an official early dismissal pass.

Although we strongly encourage all AP students to stay in school and go to their afternoon classes at the conclusion of their morning AP exam, many such students who do not have an AP exam that afternoon wish to leave school at the conclusion of their morning AP exam.

In order to process the large number of students who fall into this category, we are asking that any parent who DOES NOT wish their child with a morning AP exam to be released early from school after the conclusion of their morning AP exam to e-mail Ms. van Keulen, AP Coordinator, at Ivankeu@schools.nyc.

If we do not receive such an e-mail from the parent of guardian, a pass will be issued to the student at the conclusion of the morning exam which will permit them to leave the building. This pass should be kept by the student to show their teachers the following day.

Students with an afternoon AP exam are expected to be in school at their regular morning reporting time.
