Extended Time Paperwork

PARENTS: Submit Extended

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<u>Time Paperwork.</u>

The College Board grants extended time on assessments such as the PSAT,

SAT, and AP tests to each student with a 504 Education Plan approved by LaGuardia. The College Board is a private company, however, with its own review board.

The College Board application for extended time asks the school if the student uses all of the accomodations approved by LaGuardia in his or her 504. As a result of this inquiry, starting in September, the school will monitor the extent to which students use the accomodations, with particular attention paid to extended time.

For the 2009-10 school year, therefore, if it has been determined that you are entitled to extra time, we encourage you to take advantage of this provision on all classroom tests, standardized tests, midterm examinations, and final examinations. If you do not, The College Board may not grant you extra time on the SAT, PSAT, and AP examinations.

SITTING FOR THE AP TEST

STUDENTS: Sit for the AP Examination.

If you are in an AP class, you need to pay for the test for which that course prepares you and sit for it. The new check amount is \$86.00 per test.
